Special safeguards

Some items may require **special packing or servicing** by professionals. American Red Ball has a network of trained professionals who can handle any special needs packing or servicing required. These items may include pool tables, plasma and LCD television sets, and washer and dryer sets. Ask your moving consultant if you have a specific item that may require specialized care.



What not to pack

It is extremely crucial that items considered dangerous to transport not be included in your shipment. Items in this category include, but are not limited to, alcohols, aerosol cans, chlorinated hydrocarbons, corrosive liquids, explosives, flammable and combustible products and gases. Pack and go with you

There are possessions that you will want to keep with you. These include all medication, jewelry, cash, stocks



and bonds, important papers, small items of irreplaceable or sentimental value, birth certificates, a few days of casual and business attire, a toy or two for a child, and your address book. It is important to think about what you'll need as you travel to your new home and before the moving van arrives.

The essential box
